Classroom and field training course for novice wetland delineators and interested members of the public. Students will receive a classroom orientation to wetland plants, soils and hydrology indicators, then proceed to test points located in and around Braddock Bay Marsh. Students will learn to identify common wetland and upland plants, describe soils using USDA methodology, and recognize wetland hydrology indicators. The class will be taught by experienced wetland scientists and soil scientists. A certificate of completion will be provided to class attendees.
